

Buffalo Hunter Category

This is not a SASS recognized category. It will be a **Black Powder Only** category this year. In the Buffalo Hunter Category, you would be required to use a Big Bore Repeating Rifle or a Single Shot Big Bore Rifle. You will shoot the longer-range targets when they are available.

Rules for Buffalo Hunter Category:

- Will be shot with Black Powder or any approved BP Substitute
- Any SASS Legal Main match pistols in any caliber.
- Pistols may be shot in any SASS Legal style.
- Any main match Pistol Caliber Rifle may be used.
- Any SASS Legal shotgun may be used.
- You must use a SASS recognized Rifle Caliber Repeater or Rifle Caliber Single Shot as described in the Shooter's Handbook under Long Range or Precision Rifle (0.375" bore size or larger).
- Shooter **MUST** engage Big Bore targets when available.
- Not all stages will have the Big Bore Long Range targets on them, be prepared to use your Pistol Calber Rifle if there are no Long-Range Targets.
- This year there will be Two Categories to choose from in the Buffalo Class:
 - Single Shot Big Bore Rifle, which will shoot 4 shots at the longrange targets.
 - **Repeater Big Bore Rifle**, which will shoot 6 shots at the Long-Range targets.

Awards will be given for Buffalo Hunter, Single Shot and Buffalo Hunter, Repeater
